This lovely stone fountain was chiseled by a sculptor from South San Francisco, California. The stone was quarried in Southern Mexico and sculpted from the raw block. Varied earth colors fit into the ultimate Moorish plan for the walkways. The "water curtain" effect provides minimal sound and is a source of sparkling light either during the day or by moonlight. There are three of these beautiful fountains, one of which you will see on the cover of this publication.
